



## **Centrose to Present at 2017 Annual AACR Meeting**

Brief: Centrose to present latest findings at AACR

MADISON, Wis., February 1, 2017 – Centrose announced today that it will present its most recent data at the American Association of Cancer Research (AACR) Annual Meeting. The meeting is being held from April 1<sup>st</sup> to April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in Washington, DC at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center. Dr. James Prudent, Centrose's President and CEO will make the presentation. The theme for this year's meeting "Research Propelling Cancer Prevention and Cures" is precisely what Centrose has committed to. This annual meeting highlights the best cancer science and medicine.

Dr. Prudent will discuss the progress of EDC9 as it makes its way toward human testing. EDC9 is manufactured with a Rituximab biosimilar attached to a Centrose novel steroid. It is expected that at safe doses, EDC9 will demonstrate a strong and lasting reduction in B-cell numbers in humans. EDC9 may be useful in treating multiple B-cell related diseases such as non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, multiple sclerosis, and lupus.

In addition, Dr. Prudent will review recent findings regarding what is arguably the most important membrane protein known, the NKA. The NKA uses the majority of all our energy, interacts with multiple proteins like CD20 (Rituximab's target) and appears to be directly or indirectly regulating a large number of cellular processes and related diseases. Centrose has been investigating the NKA with EDC Technology for years and will review its recent findings at AACR2017.
